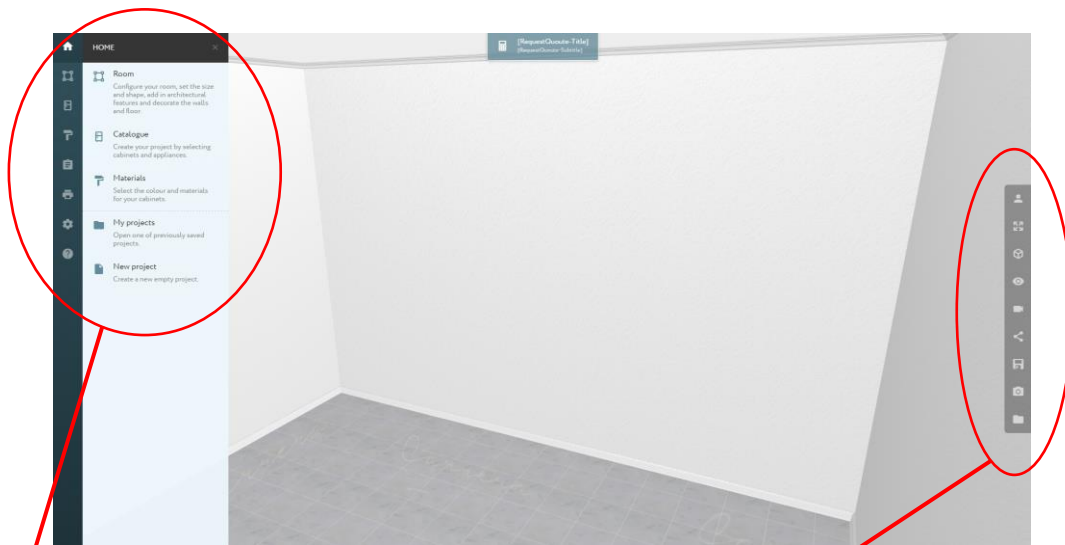

CarreraVision Designer Help Document










Welcome to Our CarreraVision Help Document! This Document will take you through the process of creating your dream space using our software. To start you off we suggest having a general idea of what you would like to create with our program, whether that be a Kitchen, Bathroom, or any other Joinery.

1. Creating an Account

First thing we will go through is how to create an account so that you can save your progress at any time. When you first open our CarreraVision Software you will have 2 side controls. I have broken down what each section controls and how they will help you navigate our site.



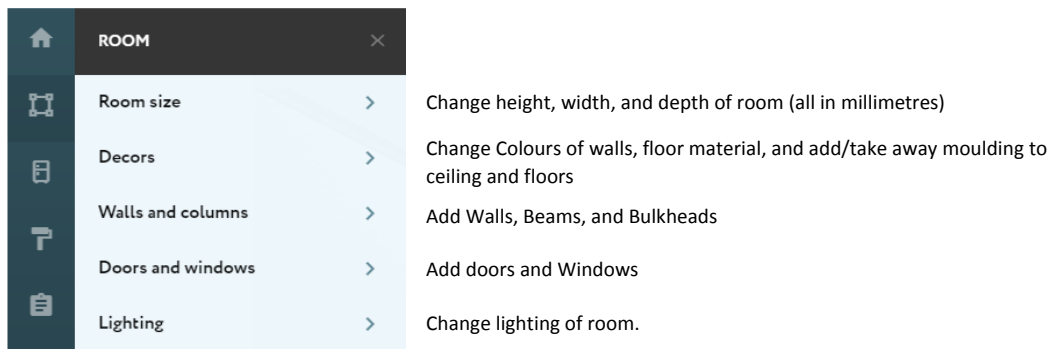
	Home
	Room – Where to set room sizing, add walls, columns, and bulkhead.
	Catalogue of Cabinets – Where you can drag and drop cabinets to create your project
	Materials – Selecting colour of cabinets and benchtop. Selection of hardware, handles, and door type (drop down finger pull)
	Elements – List of all items in project.
	Basket – Where to order, save, and view project
	Settings – Graphic settings
	Help – Tips on how to navigate camera position

We will initially start on the Right-hand side with creating our account. When selected our sign in/Sign up option you will have a pop up which will have 2 options down the bottom. Initially we will be selecting the sign-up button. Once you have created and account you can just enter the email that was used during the registration period and your personal passcode. Congratulations you have just created an account!

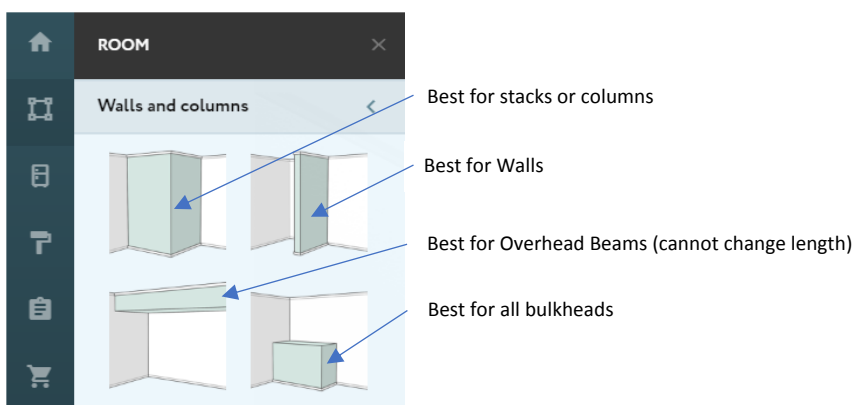
2. Setting up your Room

Now it's time to set up your room. If you have a space in mind I would suggest getting some measurements to help guide you in designing the space accurately. On your control panel on the left-hand side has the room set up area. Once you click into it I have further broken down each area within the room set up.



To start off enter in your rooms measurements, this will help you plan more realistically the rooms space. After all your measurements are in have a little fun selection your wall colour, you can match it to your current colour or you can set it up for your future colour. This will be the same with your floors, you can have this set up to match your current floor or set it up to show your new vision of the room.

Now it is time to add in any extra walls and columns. I have broken down below on each option and the best use for them.



You must drag and drop out of the catalogue and into project. Clicking on the item will not insert it into the project

PRO TIP: Add in all your cabinets first and then add in your bulkhead around any overhead or tall cabinets

To Select one of the below and have it come into your project, you will need to drag it and drop it in. To set up the walls and columns, please left click on the object in your project so that it will bring up the customization for that object. Below I have broken down how to change and create a custom wall or beam. The same can be done for windows and doors.



3. Selecting your materials and colours

Now it's time to select your materials and colours. On your left control panel click on the  to bring up all your selections for your materials. Below I have broken down the different options available in our material section.

MATERIALS	
Doors, Handles	Door type (handle or no handle), Door Colours, glazed door type, glazed door colour, handles.
Cupboards, Bench Tops	Cabinet Internals material, Open Cabinet Material, Base Set up, Kickboard colour, Benchtop Material/colour, splashback material/colour
Hardware	Overall hinges and drawer runners, overhang of wall cabinets to show drop down finger pull.
Autopick	Auto pick of colours and materials for the whole project.

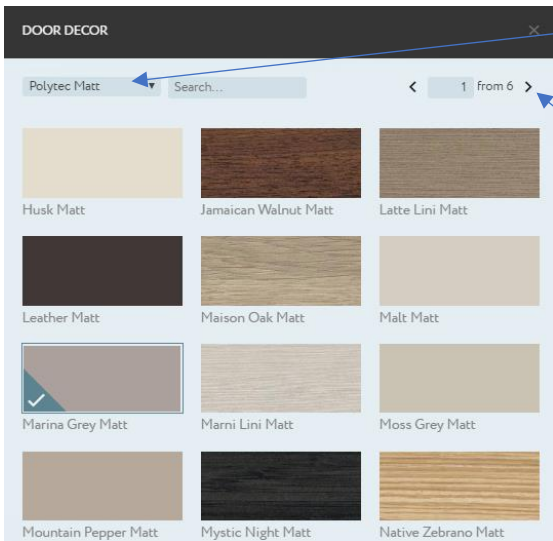
To start off we will need to select our door type. This will be split into 2 distinct categories, painted doors and pre-finished doors. For your painted doors this is a polyurethane door and can be based from any paint colour. E.g. any Dulux, Taubman's, or Poters paint colours. This is also where all the routed doors are. The second option is the Pre-finished doors, this includes all the Polytec, Laminex, Nav, and Veneer doors. Below I have broken down the different sections in the materials.

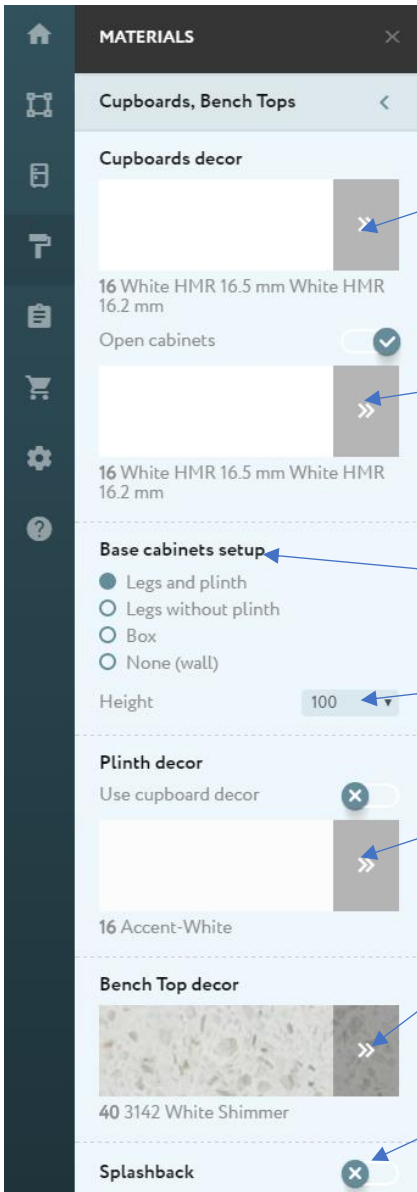
- Doors, Handles**: A toggle switch for 'Use different doors for base and overhead cupboards' is turned on. Annotation: 'To have drop down finger pull for wall cabinets this must be turned on.'
- Doors (overhead cupboards)**: A grid of door type and main/alt. decor options. Annotations: 'Click on these arrows to bring up door type and you can select from Prefinished doors and painted doors' and 'Clicking on these arrows brings up all the colours available.'
- Glazed Doors**: Options for Polytec door 42mm Brushed and Stainless. Annotation: 'These will have Glazed doors types (doors that have glass in them or mirror)'
- Doors (base cupboards)**: A grid of door type and main/alt. decor options. Annotations: 'Click on these arrows to bring up door type and you can select from Prefinished doors (Polytec colours) to painted doors (polyurethane)' and 'Clicking on these arrows brings up all the colours available. For that door type'
- Glazed doors**: Options for Polytec door 42mm Brushed and Stainless. Annotation: 'These will have Glazed doors types (doors that have glass in them or mirror)'
- Vitrine decor**: Options for glass types like Smokey glass. Annotation: 'Clicking on these arrows brings up all the glass types available for the glazed doors. E.g. Smokey, clear, frosted, and Mirror.'
- Handles**: A handle option shown. Annotation: 'This will bring up all the handle options'

PRO TIP: If you are having multiple colours e.g. dual Dulux colours and veneer cabinets your best option would be to use the alternative colour section and turn on the alternate colour for each cabinet (during the entering of each cabinets phase this will be shown exactly how)



Note this is a dropdown menu to select material and the finish

There are multiple pages of colours to choose from.



This is the internal material for the cabinets. You can have this selected to match the door colour.

This is the colour to be selected for open cabinets. PRO TIP: This controls colour of the under panel in the kitchen, if you would like it matching

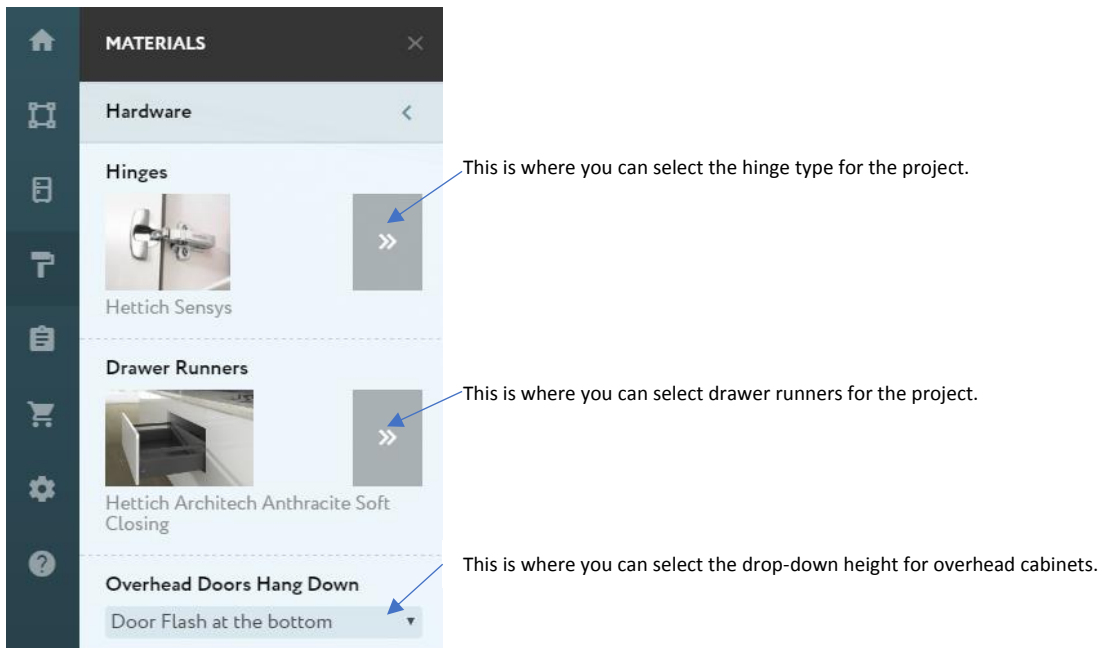
This is the base set up

This is the height of the kickboard

This is the kickboard colour. To be selected the same as the door colour or left as white.

This is the Benchtop colour and material

This is the Splashback colour, can be matched to your door colour, mirror finish, and Benchtop colour



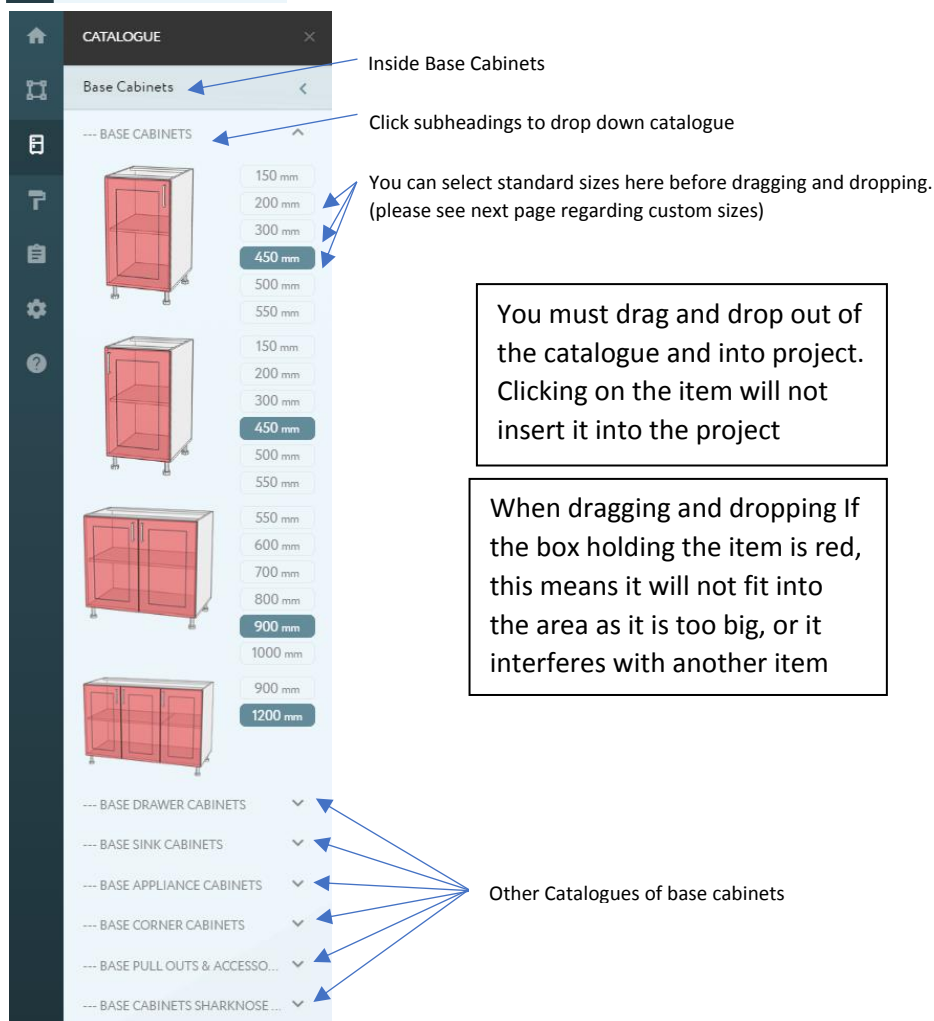
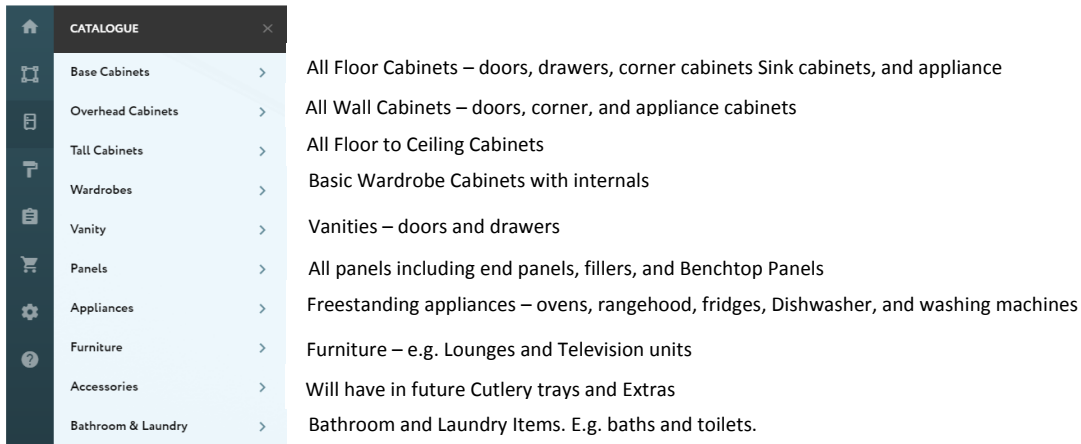
PRO TIP: if there is an under panel and you would like to show Push touch, please select 20mm drop down. If there is no under panel and you would like to show push touch leave it as flush, or if you would like to show drop down finger pull select the 20mm option. If you have an under panel and would like to show drop down, then you can select the 30mm drop down option.

4. Creating your space

Now it is finally time to add in your cabinets! On your left-hand control panel left click on the icon to bring up our catalogue of Cabinets available.



When selecting your cabinets please remember if you would like your base cabinets to have shark nose finger pull they have a separate catalogue for these.



Once you have dragged your cabinet into your project you can customise the cabinet to your specific size or specific spot. When the cabinet is in your project left click on the cabinet it will be highlighted in yellow and your left-hand control panel will open a new section to customise the specific cabinet. I have broken down each section below

Annotations:

- Clicking on the arrow will show the standard sizes. You can also highlight the number and type in an exact size to the millimetre
- This shows the position of the item, this can be manually changed. E.g. If you need a specific cabinet 200mm from the roof to be exact.
- This controls the overhang of the benchtop at the back of the cabinet as well as the left and right side manual overhang of the cabinet.
- This controls the position on the handle. All are automatically set vertically. You can change this position or make it horizontal here
- Clicking this changes the colour of the door to an alternate colour as selected in materials
- If you would like a specific door/drawer to be a specific hinge or runner this is where you can select it. Otherwise it goes off the main choice in materials.

5. Requesting a Quote

Once your Design is finished and you are happy with it, to request a quote click on button up the top in the middle of the screen. This will send us your design and allow us to give you a quote based on it.
